

Railroad Mechanic

Job Summary

Inspect, service, repair and maintain railroad work equipment and hi-rail vehicles.

Primary Activities and Responsibilities

- Ensure compliance with all railroad rules and regulations for safety, operations, and the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA)
- Inspect, maintain, troubleshoot, and repair malfunctions in diesel and gas engines, hi-rail running gear and on track equipment.
- Perform FRA and DOT mandated inspections.
- Perform periodic services on track railroad equipment.

Pay Rate

Pay rate information is subject to change based on Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Training

Certain railroad specific training will be provided.

Minimum Qualifications and Basic Competencies

- High School/GED
- 21 years of age or older
- Valid Driver's License (CDL B preferred)
- Four years' experience as a mechanic (preferably on railroad track equipment)
- Welding and fabricating experience required.
- Verbal comprehension, communication and reasoning skills, mechanical aptitude

Physical Requirements

- Heavy work, lifting up to 70 pounds.
- Stoop/bend/kneel/crouch/balance/climb on an occasional basis.

Employment Conditions

- Work safely to prevent on the job accidents and injuries.

- Wear protective equipment such as hard hat, hearing protection, safety-toe boots, or safety glasses.
- Work hours may include a nonstandard workweek, overtime, and various shift work.
- Some out-of-town work will be required.
- Work will be both indoor and outdoor in all weather conditions.
- Complete annual training and pass safety and track worker rules examination
- Requires random testing for drugs and/or alcohol.
- Must pass a post-offer medical examination, including a drug screen.
- Must pass a background screening.
